



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Portfolio Commentaries

- The portfolio returned 2.13% for the month of March, bridging the gap for this year's losses to -1.75%.
- April ended with mixed results for the equity markets, with Europe leading the way while markets across broad Asia were lacklustre in performances.
- Our gold allocation diversified the risk away from equities and bonds to add another dimension of returns that is uncorrelated to the two former asset classes.
- Balanced Portfolio was the worst performer among the 3 portfolios due to the lower allocation to gold compared with Agg portfolio and not having UOB Emerging Market Bond in the Portfolio.

Portfolio Changes

- At the end of April, we will have reduced our equity allocation to 40% of the portfolio and increase our conviction in gold by giving it 10% of our allocation.


