Dear Shareholder,

We are writing to let you know about developments taking place within Fidelity Funds impacting Sub-Funds that you are invested in.

As part of our ongoing commitment to responsible and sustainable investing, we are updating our approach to Sustainable Investing and environmental, social and governance ("**ESG**") integration, to reflect the evolving sustainable investing landscape and enhance transparency to investors.

With effect from 30 July 2024 we will be making the following updates.

# 1. Introduction of Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) scores for portfolios

We will be introducing ESG portfolio scores to promote environmental and social characteristics of certain Sub-Funds. The following Sub-Funds will aim to have an ESG score greater than that of their investment universe or benchmark. In addition, the sentence "The fund invests at least 50% of its assets in securities of [companies / issuers] with favourable environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics" or "The fund invests at least 70% of its assets in securities of [companies / issuers] with favourable environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics and up to 30% in securities of [companies / issuers] with [low but] improving ESG characteristics" (as applicable) will be removed from the investment policy of the following Sub-Funds.

Fidelity Funds - Sustainable Strategic Bond Fund will be renamed as part of changes we are making to our approach to Sustainable Investing. Fidelity Funds - Sustainable Strategic Bond Fund (to be renamed as Fidelity Funds - Strategic Bond Fund) will no longer be classified as an ESG Fund (as defined in the MAS Circular CFC 02/2022: Disclosure and Reporting Guidelines for Retail ESG Funds) in Singapore.
